Directions to National Research Coal & Energy Building Evansdale Campus, West Virginia University Morgantown, WV



#### Coming From North & South of Morgantown, WV

- Take I-79 Exit 155 (West Virginia University exit)
- Proceed toward WVU/Morgantown and US 19 South
- Go straight through traffic light (University Town Center entrance on the right)
- Go straight through traffic light bearing right past Sheetz gas station onto US 19 South.
- Move into right lane and cross the Edith Barrill Bridge (also known as the Star City Bridge).
- Continue straight through traffic light (CVS Pharmacy, Golden Corral on the right)
- If you want to park at the Coliseum, turn right at light into Coliseum
- If you want to park in one of the paid parking lots, go straight through the next traffic light (the WVU Coliseum will be on your right).
- Move into the left lane, still following 19 South.
- Turn left at the next light (Arboretum on right) onto Evansdale Drive to enter the Evansdale Campus
- When you turn onto Evansdale Drive, you will see the Creative Arts Center on your left. Continue following Evansdale Drive as it twists and turns uphill for onequarter mile and look for the NRCCE building on your left, the third of three buildings with dark glass and red architectural accents. (There is a blue sign by the entrance doors that reads "National Research Center for Coal & Energy.")
- Continue past the NRCCE building to the 4-way stop sign.
- Turn right at 4-way stop sign into short-term parking lot.

### Coming From East of Morgantown, WV

- Take I-68 West to I-79 North
- Exit 155 (West Virginia University exit)
- Proceed toward WVU/Morgantown and US 19 South
- Go straight through traffic light (University Town Center entrance on the right)
- Go straight through traffic light bearing right past Sheetz gas station onto US 19 South.
- Move into right lane and cross the Edith Barrill Bridge (also known as the Star City Bridge).
- Continue straight through traffic light (CVS Pharmacy, Golden Corral on the right)
- As you approach the top of the hill, If you want to park at the Coliseum, turn right at light into Coliseum
- If you want to park in one of the paid parking lots, go straight through the traffic light (the WVU Coliseum will be on your right).
- Move into the left lane, still following 19 South.
- Turn left at the next light (Arboretum on right) onto Evansdale Drive to enter the Evansdale Campus
- When you turn onto Evansdale Drive, you will see the Creative Arts Center on your left. Continue following Evansdale Drive as it twists and turns uphill for one-quarter mile and look for the NRCCE building on your left, the third of three buildings with dark glass and red architectural accents. (There is a blue sign by the entrance doors that reads "National Research Center for Coal & Energy.")
- Continue past the NRCCE building to the 4-way stop sign.
- Turn right at 4-way stop sign into short-term parking lot.

# **Parking Options**

There are several parking options available for those going to the NRCCE Building at WVU:


1.) FREE parking at the Coliseum



- The free lots are in front of the Coliseum (SEE MAP)
- Bus shuttles run every 15 minutes from the Coliseum to the Evansdale Campus and vice versa.
- Once you arrive at the Evansdale Campus (at the loop by the PRT station), you will have to walk a short distance to the NRCCE Building (SEE MAP)



## 2.) Paid Parking Near NRCCE Building



#### Short Term Parking Instructions

- There are several paid lots in close proximity to the NRCEE Building
- Pay machines are located at each paid parking lot. They are on the map above, circled in red.
- You can select length of time (suggest 4 hours) and a fee amount will appear on the machine display.
- Enter dollar bills or change for the amount displayed.
- A pay stub or parking "pass" will be issued from the pay machine.
- Place this pay stub in your car windshield.
- Cost to park: \$1.00 per hour.
- You may also pay via the Park Mobile app.
