The West Virginia Water Research Institute (WVWRI) is seeking a graduate or undergraduate student beginning immediately to perform the following duties:

- Field sample preparation and processing
- Bench scale lab experiments
- Other lab related work

The successful candidate should have coursework or experience in the field of Chemistry, Environmental Science, Geology, or Engineering. Related professional work experience is desirable. Experience should include performing all the duties listed above. The successful candidate should also have basic statistical analysis skills, good communication skills, and be able to work independently and interact with a variety of individuals. A working knowledge of software packages including Excel and Word is required. Candidates with 1 year or more of chemistry laboratory experience are preferring.

Note that this position is in support of a US Department of Energy (DOE) project that includes restrictions on foreign nationals from sanctioned countries of North Korea, Iran, Sudan, and Syria. Foreign nationals from other non-sanctioned countries may be responsible for providing to the US DOE specific information to ensure compliance with all the requirements for access approval. Access approval for individuals from countries identified on the US Department of State list of State Sponsors of Terrorism must receive final approval authority from the Secretary of Energy before they can commence work.
